ENGL241N: American Literature Civil War to Present

This course samples American literature from the late nineteenth century to contemporary time. Scott Fitzgerald, Langston Hughes, Allen Ginsburg, Sylvia Plath, Amy Tan, Toni Morrison, Maya Angelou and others may be selected for study.
