Graduate Placement

The College is sensitive to the career counseling needs of students and provides a variety of services including Career Coach which is a computerized career assessment and interest inventory. Students are assisted in their search for employment through notification of employment opportunities, access to skill building seminars such as resume writing and job search strategies. Historically, approximately 90% of the graduates are employed or continue their education within 90 days of graduation. NCC uses College Central Network (CCN) as its official resume and job posting service. Local employers post jobs exclusively to our school via the CCN site. Students and alumni can create an account profile to:

- Easily search and apply to local and national Full-time, Part-time, Internship/Co-op job opportunities
- Create and upload their résumé and career portfolio to make available to employers
- Access event announcements, career advice documents, Podcasts, videos and articles
