How Do I Receive VA Education Benefits at NCC?

- 1. Apply for admission to an eligible degree or certificate program with our Admissions Office.
- 2. Apply for VA Education Benefits through the VA at https://www.va.gov/education/how-to-apply/
- 3. Submit a copy of your Joint Service or Community College of the Air Force transcript, and transcripts from all previously attended institutions.
- 4. Submit the appropriate documentation for the benefit you wish to utilize:
 - a. Chapter 31 (VA Vocational Rehabilitation) Request your VR&E counselor to submit the approval to the College.
 - b. Chapter 33 (Post 9/11 GI Bill)- Submit your Certificate of Eligibility that you received in the mail or your eBenefits Education Enrollment Status Page.
 - c. Chapter 30 (Montgomery GI Bill), Chapter 1606 (Montgomery GI Bill Selected Reserve), or Chapter 35 (Dependents) Submit your Certificate of Eligibility that you received in the mail.
- 5. Enroll only in courses required for your academic program. Courses not required for your program cannot be certified for VA education benefits.
- 6. Notify the VA Student Counselor any time you have a change in enrollment (add/drop/switch).

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
