The College supports the Drug Free Schools and Communities Act Amendment of 1989, P.L. 101-226, and complies with this and all Federal, State and local laws pertaining to controlled substances, including alcohol.

The abuse of alcohol imposes consequences on the individual, the members of the College community and the community as a whole. NCC is concerned about alcohol and other drugs and its pervasive detrimental impact on the quality of campus life at NCC. NCC encourages a commitment from students, faculty and staff to make every effort to alleviate substance abuse problems on this campus and in the surrounding community.
