

ECE290N : Capstone Practicum II

This capstone course offers students the opportunity to apply and integrate the skills, theories, and knowledge gained throughout the Early Childhood Associate Degree program. Participants will engage in a field-based practicum in a licensed early childhood setting, supervised by an experienced and degreed early childhood teacher.

The practicum experience will involve observing, developing, and implementing developmentally appropriate learning activities and environments, managing the classroom, and collaborating with parents and the teaching team. Students are required to complete a total of 112 hours on-site and attend a one-hour weekly seminar.

To culminate this experience, students will create and present a professional portfolio and a thematic teaching unit. This capstone experience covers all six NAEYC Standards for Early Childhood Professional Preparation.
