

FIN220N : Corporate Finance

This course introduces the core principles of corporate finance used in organizational decision-making. Students examine present value, bond and stock valuation, risk and return, and capital budgeting, while learning key tools for evaluating investments and financial performance. Additional topics include market efficiency, capital structure, payout policy, options, risk management, and mergers. Emphasis is placed on developing practical financial reasoning skills for effective managerial decision-making.
