

HIST110N : Ancient Civilizations of the World

This course will focus on the development of world cultures and trends from the earliest societies to the 15th century. It includes first-wave civilizations in China, India, Southwest Asia, Africa, and the Americas, as well as later civilizations, including empires in Europe, the Byzantine Empire, the Islamic World, and the Mongols. Discussion will focus on comparing and contrasting the characteristics of civilizations as well as identifying their political, technological, economic, ideological, and cultural achievements. Special emphasis will be placed on identifying the ideas, people, and events that have helped to shape the modern world.
